#### MARIST VINTAGE LUNCH

#### JERSEYS FOR TIMOR-LESTE

The Marist Rosalie Cerise & Blue jerseys that have been worn at the Tribute Match each year by Ashgrove First XV are being retired. Next year we are planning to have the White Knights jersey introduced and worn at the Tribute Match. The Committee discussed a use for the retired jerseys:

- a) Send them to Timor-Leste Teacher's College for the students to wear. (It was later confirmed that the jerseys would be far too big for the students in Timor-Leste)
- b) Offer them up for sale to the Association (The funds from the sale of these could be donated to the school in Timor-Leste).

#### F.O.G.I. (Friends Of Gallipoli Incorporated)

In 2022 the Association was presented with two Gallipoli Pines by Lt Col Garry Spencer (retired). These have been donated to schools around Australia to be placed in a prominent place at the school in memory of those who served or lost their lives in ADF campaigns.

The Management Committee at the time accepted these trees and approached the Old Boys of Marist College Ashgrove to have these planted in the grounds of Ashgrove and establish a "Memorial Plaque" of those who have "Fallen" (past students of both Rosalie and Ashgrove). The aim is to have the two trees planted near the new "Junior School" and to have a Commemoration Ceremony on "Remembrance Day" 2024.

#### AMS (Australian Marist Solidarity)

The Committee is looking at the possibility of setting up a "Bursary" to assist a student in Timor-Leste to go to Teachers College or that we present "a student" with a one-off "Graduation Gift".

#### MEMBERSHIP FEE

As decided at the last AGM, a Membership Fee of \$25 will be commencing in July 2024. This will be an annual fee and benefits of being a "paid-up member" will be released in the upcoming months. Initially, each paid-up member will receive a Marist Rosalie Old Boys lapel badge which was designed specifically for this.

#### AGM

Last month, the Management Committee discussed bringing the AGM forward to either August or September. Holding the AGM at the end of November made it difficult for the committee to get up and running before the end of the year. The date for this year's AGM has been set for August 24 2024. The Paddo Tavern have provided a quote for the AGM and the lunch to follow.
